1. RULES

1. The Race shall be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and Australia Sailing (AS) Special Regulations, Category 6 for all Yachts.
2. Any change made to this Notice of Race prior to each race will be posted on the CYC website and Facebook page. Changes will be posted on the Club Notice Board.
3. RRS 55 is amended, adding the following sentence to the rule: "However, discarding cotton, wool or any other biodegradable material when setting a sail is permitted."
4. The Sailing Instructions and any Supplementary Instructions will be posted on the Club Notice Board.

2. VENUE

1. Racing will be conducted from the Cairns Inlet and Trinity Bay

3. ENTRIES

- 3.1. Entry nominations shall be lodged on sailsys prior to racing.
- 3.2. Entry Fee, \$20.00 for members, One Owner, no cost .

Non Members must have a current Sailpass from 1 January 2022 as per changes to Rule 46 ,
Sailpass Cost is \$25 per race. Up to 4 Sailpass can be used to contribute to cost of Full Membership

4. YACHT DIVISIONS

Division 1 Monohulls with Handicap $>.85$

Division 2 will include the J24's and any other vessels with PHS Handicap $\leq .85$

Division 3 :Multihulls.

The Race Officer may provide shorter or longer courses for particular divisions subject to conditions forecast and on the day.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACE

Subject to change and dependent on weather.

Briefing will be held in the CYC Marlin Marina Boat Shed at 0900 on Sunday.

Start times will be staggered, with a start time for each vessel being issued at the 9am. briefing. First boats will start at approximately 10am. Faster boats will be allocated later start times based on their current handicaps.

6. PRIZES

First Prize for each division will be awarded at The Boat Shed after racing.

7. INSURANCE

All Yachts competing are to have liability insurance cover of a minimum \$10,000,000.

8. LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this Race entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race.

The organising committee will not accept any liability for damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, or prior to, during or after the event for both on water and on land activities. By participating in this Race and associated events each competitor agrees to release the race organisers and all persons and groups involved in the race from any liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
